

The investigation into the shooting death of Robert Dusseau continues by Detectives from the Negaunee State Police, Marquette County Sheriff's Depart, Marquette City Police, and the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms.

An autopsy is scheduled for Thursday February 25<sup>th</sup>.

As investigative leads have been developed it is believed that the homicide was committed some time after 4:00 PM on 2-23-2010.

Witnesses have provided investigators with a description of a person seen at the business on the afternoon of the shooting. The person is described as a white male, between the ages of 35 - 45 years of age, and is approximately 5'10''tall, weighing 200 - 220 pounds. The suspect has brown hair that covers the ears, and was wearing silver or gold rimed eye glasses. Facial hair was also present in the form of a close cropped goatee.

A forensic artist's depiction of the suspect's description will be developed later this day for circulation.

The Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms has announced, their agency is offering a \$5,000 reward for information resulting in the arrest and conviction of the person or persons involved in the death of Robert Dusseau.
