

Two weeks after the shooting death of Robert Dusseau Detectives continue to investigate tips from the public and leads being developed.

Two forensic drawings of persons of interest are still in circulation. These two people are believed to have been in the Quik Cash and Guns store on the day of the shooting. The hooded individual was in the business at 5:00 P.M. and is described as a w/m in his late twenties or early thirties, and was wearing a tan colored hooded sweatshirt with a zippered front.

The individual sketched as wearing eye glasses was seen in the business at 5:30 P.M. and is described as a w/m between the ages of 35 & 45 years of age, and is approximately 5'10"tall, weighing 200 - 220 pounds. This person has brown hair that covers the ears, and was wearing silver or gold rimed glasses. Facial hair was also present in the form of a close cropped goatee.

Either of these people may have information valuable to the investigation.

Detectives are still interested in any one who may have seen the victim's vehicle which was recovered from the parking lot of the Birchwood apartments located on Werner Street in Marquette Township. The vehicle was driven into the lot by at 7:30 PM on February 23, and the driver was observed walking away from the vehicle and walking in the area of Werner and Erickson Street in Marquette Township.

The vehicle was a 2007 Pontiac, 4 door Vibe, blue in color, having a rear hatchback door. A Michigan Registration plate was affixed to the rear of the vehicle.

The Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms is still offering a reward of **\$10,000** for information resulting in the arrest and conviction of the person or persons involved in the death of Robert Dusseau.

Additionally Crime Stoppers is offering up to \$1,000 reward in addition to the \$10,000 offered by Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms Bureau.

Police officials are asking the public for assistance with any information relating to the identification of the people in the forensic drawings and the identity of any person seen walking in the area of Werner and Erickson Streets, at 7:30 PM on 2-23-10.
